Authority through Relation – Parental Presence as a Systemic Concept

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NVR AND NEW AUTHORITY – HISTORY AND DEVELOPMENTS AT IF WEINHEIM

1999 The team of IF Weinheim invites Haim Omer to Germany for the first time to learn about his ideas of NVR and his work with parents in Israel. **NVR meets systemic therapy** – the ideas grow in friendly collaboration between Haim Omer, Arist von Schlippe and Michael Grabbe / IF Weinheim

Since 2000 Several workshops with Haim Omer, Uri Weinblatt, Idan Amiel at IF Weinheim, today as a part of the workshop design "Weinheim International Friends"

Since 2001 More than 200 in-house trainings and lectures about Parental Coaching / NVR and New Authority in institutions of child and youth welfare services, psychiatric hospitals for children and youths and schools in Germany, Austria and Switzerland. After some follow-ups several institutions integrated the ideas of NVR and New Authority into their general offers and internalized them (e.g. SOS Kinderdorf Hamburg, Eylardus Werk Bad Bentheim, Interkulturelle Begegnungsprojekte Coesfeld, Ohlebusch Stuttgart, Neukirchener Erziehungsverein, Connect Hanau,
